

## COOKIE POLICY

Version of September 2021

The private limited liability company, incorporated in accordance with Belgian law, "**APPWISE**", with registered office at 3590 Diepenbeek, Watertorenstraat 2, with company registration number 0503.920.245 and known to the VAT-administration under number BE 0503.920.245 (hereinafter referred to as "**Appwise**", "**we**" or "**us**");

Appwise uses cookies to improve the browsing experience at <https://appwise.be/> (hereinafter referred to as the "**Website**"). These cookies enable certain functions on our Website or measure how visitors use our Website.

With this cookie policy ("**Cookie Policy**") we wish to inform you, as a visitor to our Website, about the cookies and other tracking methods we use (and the way we do this).

### What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is placed in your computer's browser or on your mobile device by a website's server when you consult this site. The cookie contains a unique code that allows your browser to be recognized during visits to the website (this is a so-called 'session' cookie) or during subsequent, repeated visits (a so-called 'permanent' cookie). Cookies can be placed by the server of the website you visit or by partners with whom the website cooperates (e.g. Google Analytics, ...). A website's server can only read the cookies it has placed itself and has no access to other information stored on your computer or mobile device. Cookies are stored on your computer or mobile device in a specific folder of your browser.

Cookies generally make interaction between the visitor and the website easier and faster and help the visitor to navigate between the different parts of the website. Cookies can also be used to make the content of the website more relevant to the visitor and adapt it to his personal taste and needs.

### This Website uses different types of cookies and tracking methods

#### I. Strictly necessary cookies:

These cookies are necessary for purely technical reasons for the use of the Website. In view of the technical necessity, there is only an information obligation and they are placed as soon as one enters the Website.

#### II. Functional cookies

These cookies improve the functionality of the Website by storing your preferences. We use functional cookies, among other things, to:

- Remember your choice of language;
- Keeping you logged in to our Website.

These cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of this Website. You cannot refuse them if you want to browse the Website, but they will only be placed after a choice has been made regarding the use of cookies.

### III. Analytical cookies

Analytical cookies allow us to measure how visitors use our Website. Based on this information, user statistics and reports can be generated. This enables us to improve the performance of the Website and thus provide a better user experience.

The analytical cookies collect, among other things, the following data

- The number of visitors on the Website;
- How long a visitor visits the Website;
- Search queries of visitors;
- Information about the browser and devices used to visit our Website;
- How the visitor ended up on the Website;
- The speed of our Website;
- The fonts used on the Website.

IV. Advertisement cookies

With your permission, we or our advertisers will place tracking cookies on your device to track your online browsing behaviour over time and provide relevant offers and recommendations tailored to your personal preferences. This also allows us to find out which other websites in our network you visit.

The following data is collected by means of tracking cookies:

- Where on our Website you are;
- Which pages you are viewing;
- From which device you are accessing the Website;
- What you click on on the Website;
- Web pages visited;
- IP addresses;
- Cookie content;
- Device settings.

If you have not given your consent but still see offers from us, these offers are not based on your behavior.

<b>pagead/1p-user-list/#</b>	Session	Google.com	Detects how the user navigates between sites.
<b>test_cookie</b>	1 day	DoubleClick.net	Used to check if the user's browser support cookies.
<b>UserMatchHistory</b>	29 days	Linkedin.com	Used to track visitors on multiple websites, in order to present relevant advertisement based on the visitor's preferences.

V. Social media cookies

Social media cookies are used to integrate and interact with social networking sites on our Website. Our Website contains social media plug-ins, such as from Facebook, Instagram, .... When you click the social media button, the social media network places cookies on your device. These cookies allow the network to see what you are doing on the internet and use this data for its own purposes. Appwise has no control over the information collected by the social media network.
